**NON-REGULAR CLASSES:** Multiple Dog Entries

**Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dogs and their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. Get only to be judged based on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard of the breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class.

**Brood Bitch Class** - Same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**NOTE FOR BOTH:** The Stud Dog/Brood Bitch may be entered separately in regular classes not of a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition at the regular entry fee of \$ 30.00 with Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Class indicated on the entry form in the space for "Additional Classes" with the additional fee of \$ 30.00. The Get/Produce MUST be entered and shown individually in one of the regular classes or Best of Breed Competition. There is no additional entry fee for the Get/Produce as participants with their Stud Dog/Brood Bitch.

**Brace** - This class shall be for two American Water Spaniel irrespective of sex, similar in appearance, performing in unison with at least one common owner and presented in the ring with no more than two handlers. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at the time of the entry. Entry forms must be submitted for each dog and submitted to the Show Secretary at one time. The entry fee is \$ 30.00 for the pair, if this is the only class in which they are entered. Specify "Brace Only" in the space for "Dog Show Class". If a dog that is part of a Brace is entered in a regular class, specify "Brace Class" in the "Additional Classes". If more than one Brace is entered by the same owner(s) the dogs comprising one Brace must be designated - "Brace No1", "Brace No2" etc.

### Junior Showmanship Competition

**Novice Junior Class:** For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Intermediate Class:** For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Novice Senior Class:** For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have not won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

**Open Junior Class:** For Boys & Girls at least 9 and under 12 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition.

**Open Intermediate Class:** For Boys & Girls at least 12 and under 15 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition.

**Open Senior Class:** For Boys & Girls at least 15 and under 18 years of age on the day of the show, who at the time entries close, have won three first places in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show, with competition.

**MASTER CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won ten first places, with competition present, in an Open Class at a licensed or member show. The calendar for this class will be November 1 - October 31 of the following year. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry without charge, the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to compete for the following year

## NOTICE—WI RABIES REGULATIONS

In order to comply with the provisions of Wisconsin Statutes [s. 95.21 (2)] and Administrative Codes [s. ATCP 11.52], relating to the Statewide Rabies Control Program, the owner of any dog kept or exhibited in Wisconsin (other than a dog kept for educational or scientific purposes) shall have the dog vaccinated against rabies by a veterinarian at no later than 5 months of age and revaccinated within one year after the initial vaccination. Any person (including out-of-state exhibitors) who imports a dog into Wisconsin (for exhibition or any other purpose) must have a valid interstate health certificate or certificate of veterinary inspection for that dog, regardless of the age of the dog. The certificate must be completed by a veterinarian; accompany the dog when it enters this state; and indicate the current vaccination status of the dog. Vaccinations shall be administered by a veterinarian and comply with age and time standards and label instructions approved by the federal bureau for the type of vaccine used. Additional information regarding these regulations may be obtained from the Wisconsin State Veterinarian at 608-224-4888.

**Errors on** Entry Blanks: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**Show-giving** Club, Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs, or property, and further assume no responsibility for injury to children under the control of parents or guardians.

**Cash Prizes** will be presented in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of he show is over and the Secretary advised at once. The Secretary and show-giving club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**A recording** fee of .50 cents and an event fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club, Show, Obedience Trial, or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to AKC. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the fee is collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 14, Section 2)

**All dogs** must be held on leash except when in the exercise area or crated.

**Judges** will not wait for any dog holding up a class.

**No entry** shall be made or accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance.

**Exhibitors** should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

**Judging** schedule and map to the show site will be available as soon as possible after the closing of entries.

**OBEEDIENCE & RALLY Transfers** are accepted at this trial. Please note: January 1, 2009 Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3, Jump Heights required with entry. Include Jump Height on entry form with class. Entries without Jump Height will be judged at the end of the class.

**Obedience & Rally** classes will be judged in ascending order.

**BITCHES (Obedience & Rally)** that come into season after the closing date for entries may have the entry fee less \$10.00 per dog per class refunded upon written request of the owner or handler before the start of judging on the day of the trial.

the flushing parts of the AWSC test are extremely similar. The AWSC tests have a lot more retrieving in them, as well as an extra level (for a total of 4 levels). Again, at this year's Nationals we will use the AKC test as the flushing portion of the AWSC tests. If a handler wants to, he can enter only the AKC portion of the test. If a handler wants to run the AWSC working certificate test, he needs to enter both the AKC test and the appropriate level of AWSC test.

AWSC test and what to do if you want to participate-The first step will be to decide what level AWSC test you want to run and enter that level. The second step would be to pick the appropriate AKC spaniel test level that would satisfy the requirements. Since we have 4 levels of AWSC tests and only three levels of AKC tests, there will be one crossover. Below is the guideline-

AWSC Started- AKC Junior Hunter

AWSC Working Dog- AKC Senior Hunter

AWSC Working Dog Excellent- AKC Senior Hunter

AWSC Working Dog Superior- AKC Master Hunter

These AKC levels provide the basis for flushing work that will satisfy the AWSC requirements at each level. Although there could be combinations that will work, this is highly recommended from the hunt test committee.

Why We've Organized the Test the Way We Have. Again, this year, the Hunt Test Committee's goal is to streamline the tests and run them efficiently. As Each Dog and handler completes a test component, they will move on to the next test component. Basically, if a dog and handler are not waiting to run or running a specific AKC test, they should be waiting to run or running a specific AWSC test, and vice versa, in order to speed up the testing process. Test locations will be in close proximity to one another, so handlers and dogs will not have difficulty moving between tests. (So, to put it simply, when you complete a test component, go to the next test. Little or no waiting!)

#### **Important Notes.**

There are slight differences in the AKC and AWSC tests that make some crossover impossible. For example, the AKC Spaniel Senior and Master have an extra testing element, a hunt dead test, that is not part of any AWSC tests. While this is a component to passing the AKC portion of the test, it will not affect the ability of the handler to move on to the AWSC portion of the test. Passing the AKC test is not a requirement for moving on, but passing the elements of flushing would be.

Please familiarize yourself with the RULES of BOTH the AKC and the AWSC tests. The rules for both can be found on the Club's website.

Rosettes will be awarded for both tests each evening.

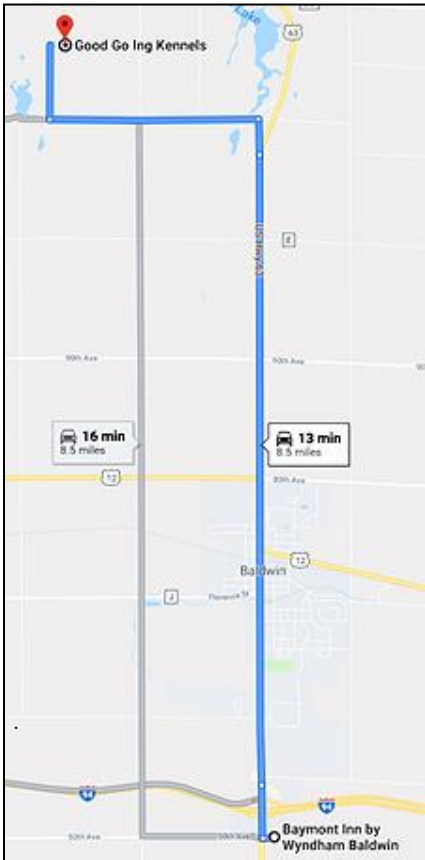
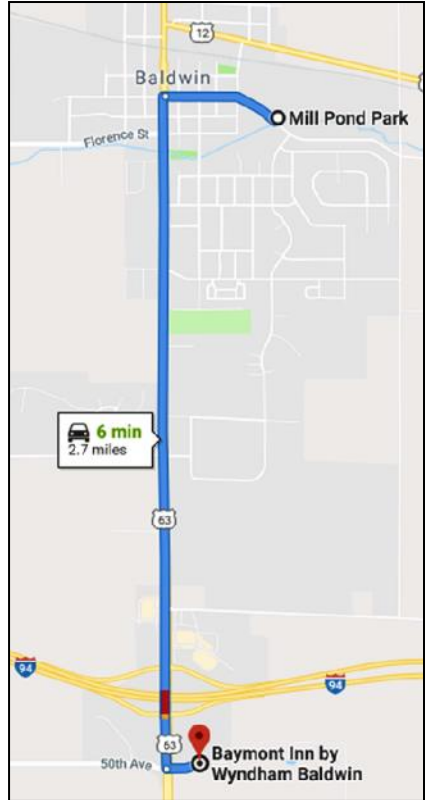
